

Strategic advice and foresighting

Mapping white space opportunities in urban development

We supported one of the largest foundations in the world to explore the health impact potential of investing in healthier urban environments. Through a white space opportunity mapping focused on urban development, city planning, and public space design, we identified areas where strategic interventions could deliver significant health benefits. Our approach combined comprehensive research review, interviews with leading experts and practitioners, and creative ideation sessions with the foundation and external stakeholders. The mapping informed early scoping of potential future strategic investment areas for the foundation.

Organisational development and good governance

We help clients navigate transitions, strengthen internal structures, and build governance frameworks that enable long-term impact and sustainability.:

Change management: We support foundations through transformation, helping leadership and teams adapt to new strategies, structures, or operating models. We design change processes that build buy-in and maintain momentum, ensuring sustainable transitions.

Organisational development: We assess and enhance organisational effectiveness - from clarifying roles and strengthening team dynamics to improving internal systems. Our approach aligns capacity-building with strategic ambitions.

Good governance: We establish and refine governance structures that balance accountability with agility, including board effectiveness reviews, governance frameworks, and alignment of practices with mission and values. Our in-house legal team provides additional support as needed.

Establishing shared governance for a cross-foundation knowledge centre

Ramboll supported three major international foundations in creating a joint governance model to co-invest in a new knowledge centre for early childhood education. We designed the partnership structure that enabled these foundations to move from independent actors to formal co-investors with aligned decision-making. Through rapid evidence review and interviews with over 100 stakeholders, we helped shape both the research programme and the governance framework. This dual focus ensured the foundations could effectively collaborate while keeping the research center focused on delivering practical, evidence-based knowledge to parents and early childhood professionals.

Impact investment and advisory

Ramboll's team of sustainable finance and economics advisors specialises in enabling the intentional use of both financial and philanthropic investments to generate a positive outcome:

Fund strategy and structuring: We support clients to design their theory of change, design their fund /portfolio structure and embed the relevant investment frameworks for impact investing.

Screening and investment execution: We help clients align their capital allocation and deployment with the intent to generate a positive impact. We screen potential investment opportunities and conduct impact due diligence reviews, identifying where greater clarity, data, or alignment is needed.

Portfolio management and active ownership: We aid clients to measure the impact their investments make in both a quantitative and qualitative manner, report this to stakeholders and actively engage with their portfolios to deepen the impact generated.

Exit strategy and impact continuity: We support endowments and impact investors to responsibly exit their holdings to ensure mission-lock. to exit.

Creating an in-depth understanding of the Danish impact investment market

In collaboration with a newly established national partnership, Ramboll developed a baseline analysis of the Danish impact investment market, focusing on both green and social impact investments. The objective was to gain an in-depth understanding of the current Danish impact investment landscape. The analysis maps the ecosystem for impact investments, identifies key barriers and opportunities, and estimates the size and characteristics of the sector. The resulting report has helped define the future-looking strategic priorities for further mobilising the Danish impact investment market.

Systemic change and collective impact

Ramboll helps clients move from traditional funding to collaborative models that address root causes, build ecosystem capacity, and create lasting change:

Partner capacity building: We help clients strengthen funded organisations and networks through developmental partnerships. This includes co-designing capacity programs, establishing mentoring and peer-learning, and creating funding mechanisms that enable partner growth.

Collective impact facilitation: We convene and coordinate multi-stakeholder initiatives for systems-level change through stakeholder mapping, collaborative strategy development, and shared measurement frameworks that align diverse actors toward common goals.

Participatory grantmaking: We design participatory approaches that redistribute decision-making power to communities. This includes developing processes, governance structures, and capacity-building strategies that enable meaningful participation while maintaining accountability.

Supporting mission-driven innovation in Sweden

Ramboll supported a national Swedish innovation agency to design and deliver a mobilisation process for a new strategic innovation programme. We brought together hundreds of organisations from different sectors through workshops, lectures, and networking events to build shared understanding of systems-level change and mission-driven innovation. Using insights from behavioural economics and systems thinking, we helped stakeholders develop new networks and practical approaches to tackling complex challenges. This work enabled both government agencies and participating organisations to better design and lead innovation processes aimed at systemic impact.



Project management and implementation support

Assessing family-wide impacts at the Mary Elizabeth's Hospital

PMO support for national children's wellbeing initiative Ramboll provided strategic advisory and PMO support for a multi-billion DKK national initiative funded by a major international foundation and corporation. The programme harnesses football's power to make Denmark the world's best country for children to grow up in.

We designed the overall programme structure and governance framework across three tracks: capital infrastructure, social impact grants, and nationwide engagement. Our work included developing internal programme management capacity, establishing the budget and implementation plan, and creating governance models and management procedures. Ramboll continues as a strategic partner during implementation to ensure successful execution and lasting impact.

Assessing family-wide impacts at the Mary Elizabeth Hospital, DK

We supported the evaluation of a major new public hospital in Copenhagen that aspires to set new standards for the treatment of children and their families. The evaluation was funded by one of the largest international foundations in the world and provided knowledge about the adverse effects that not only the patient but the whole family experiences when a child is hospitalised, and how these adverse effects could be reduced by rethinking the experience of hospitalisation. The evaluation thereby highlighted the full potential of investing in a new and improved children's hospital approach.
